
An Order for Compline

THE Lord Almighty grant us a quiet night and a perfect end. **Amen.**


O God, make speed to save us;

One of the following Psalms is prayed

PSALM 4

HEAR me when I call, O God of my righteousness: / thou hast set me at liberty when I was in trouble; have mercy upon me, and hearken unto my prayer.

O YE children of mortals, how long will ye blaspheme mine honour, / and have such pleasure in vanity, and seek after falsehood?

Know this also, that the LORD hath chosen to himself the one that is godly; / when I call upon the LORD, he will hear me.

Stand in awe, and sin not; / commune with your own heart, and in your chamber, and be still.

Offer the sacrifice of righteousness, / and put your trust in the LORD.

There be many that say, 'Who will show us any good?' / LORD, lift thou up the light of thy countenance upon us.

Thou hast put gladness in my heart, / more than when grain and wine increase.

PSALM 139

O LORD, thou hast searched me out and known me: / thou knowest my down-sitting and mine up-rising; thou understandest my thoughts from afar.

Thou art about my path and about my bed, / and art acquainted with all my ways.

For lo, there is not a word in my tongue, / but thou, O LORD, knowest it altogether.

Thou hast beset me behind and before, / and laid thine hand upon me.

Such knowledge is too wonderful and excellent for me: / I cannot attain unto it.

Whither shall I go then from thy spirit? / or whither shall I flee from thy presence?

If I climb up into heaven, thou art there: / if I go down to hell, thou art there also.

If I take the wings of the morning, / and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,

COME unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart; and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. *Matthew 11. 28-30*

or

IS not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? *Isaiah 58.6-7*

or

FOR when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous person will one die: yet peradventure for a good person some would even dare to die. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. *Romans 5.6-8* For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom: But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumbling block, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than that of humans; and the weakness of God is stronger than that of humans. *1 Corinthians 1.18, 22-25*

which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; To be a light to lighten the Gentiles,


and to be the glory of thy people Israel.

MAY the Almighty and merciful Lord grant unto you pardon and remission of all your sins, time for amendment of life, and the grace and comfort of the Holy Spirit. **Amen**. Here follows a song

VISIT, we beseech thee, O Lord, this place, and drive from it all the snares of the enemy; let thy holy angels dwell herein to preserve us in peace; and may thy blessing be upon us evermore; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.

LIGHTEN our darkness, we beseech thee, O Lord; and by thy great mercy defend us from all perils and dangers of this night; for the love of thy only Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ. **Amen**.

One or more of the following prayers may be added.

KEEP watch, dear Lord, with those who work, or watch, or weep this night, and give your angels charge over those who sleep. Tend the sick, O Lord; give rest to the weary, bless the dying, soothe the suffering, have mercy on the afflicted, shield the joyous; and all for your love's sake. **Amen**.

LOOK down, O Lord, from thy heavenly throne, and illuminate the darkness of this night with thy celestial brightness, and from the sons and daughters of light banish the deeds of darkness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.

BE present, O merciful God, and protect us through the silent hours of this night, so that we who are wearied by the changes and chances of this fleeting world, may repose upon thy eternal changelessness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.

We will lay us down in peace and take our rest; **For it is thou, Lord, only, that makest us dwell in safety.** The Lord be with you; **And with thy spirit.**

Let us bless the Lord;

Thanks be to God.

THE Almighty and merciful Lord, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, bless, preserve, and keep us.
